Location of meeting: Temple Baptist Church, 313 18th St SW, Great Falls, MT

Call to Order: 7:03 PM by Commissioner Chuck Rogers.

Roll call: Commissioner Charles Rogers, Commissioner Scott Lankford, Secretary Janet Fulmer

Public Attendance: Judy Rogers, Dennis Croxford, Fred Fairhurst, Aspen Northerner, Trina Mans, Nicky Putnam, Eric Bailey, Sandy Mares

Reading of Minutes: Minutes of April 18th, 2023, approved as read.

Treasurer's Report: Cash balance \$480,703.40, Restricted Cash balance \$37,851.16, Emergency Operations balance \$24,474.16, Taxes Receivable \$29,633.06.

Inspection Report – Commissioner Rogers stated levee recently dried out and able to get onto, looked at North end with trees down at access road on river side, also new fence top and middle wire on east end by Hannas was down which Rogers stated he would get out with some staples to repair.

Fencing Report – Commissioner Lankford stated he was in contact with Dennis at Fairfield Fencing company, Dennis and Scott would look at Friday afternoon having Fred Fairhurst present as well.

Contract Status Report – Commissioner Rogers stated signed contracts with Bug Doctor and Doctor Lawn, spraying would start as soon as dried out.

Snowpack & Flood Forecast Report – Commissioner Lankford stated Gibson should spill in next couple days, under control and fine.

Section 408 Status Report – Commissioner Rogers stated Cascade County Floodplain Administrator requesting full Hydrological Study on Sun River to put box in, estimated \$80,000.00 expense to the District, Great West Engineering to follow up with DNRC for override of the requirement. Rogers opened the lake drain on the 8th and had been filling the lake until today, equalized today and closed gate.

Woody Vegetation Removal Report – Commissioner Rogers stated he has been in contact with Donnie Leitheiser with Western Enterprises, would try to meet with him again after viewing the levee on Friday to determine trees that need removed, drainage structures are grown up making access to flap gates difficult.

Flap Gate Re-Coating Report – Commissioner Lankford talked with Mike Andre with Andre Excavation, who is super busy, but would look as soon as possible, as well as T&L Painting, due to equipment being able to get on levee and needing to remain on site for performance of work. Rogers stated security would be sufficient. Lankford stated would have to be sandblasted and painted twice.

Drainage Structure Repairs – Commissioner Rogers stated nothing is going on in that area currently, but Andre Excavation has a list of items that had been approved at a prior meeting that need to be completed.

Insurance Report – Commissioner Rogers stated all insurances have been applied for and paid for.

Status of Worker's Compensation Insurance Application – Commissioner Rogers stated the District made an initial payment few days earlier therefore covered with Workers Compensation. Lankford asked about the confined space to inspect concrete, which Rogers stated they inspected the East Watson Coulee pipe that has a gap that was filled with concrete and has bulge, which Rogers and Great West Engineering did inspect, looks same as 3 years prior, and annual checks are not needed until next pipes inspection.

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Appointment – Commissioner Rogers made motion to appoint Fred L. Fairhurst to the Board of the West Great Falls Flood Control & Drainage District as the Division C Commissioner to finish the term of Kelly Manzer, motion passed, Fred L. Fairhurst took Oath of Office and sworn in.

Secretarial Contract – A motion was made to renew the secretarial contract. After a lengthy discussion and Janet Fulmer's agreement, Commissioner Fairhurst made motion to amend the renewal motion to one that would keep secretary on without a contract for 30-days allowing the commissioners time to review the contract and discuss at the next meeting, all commissioners agreed with the amended motion.

Levee Access for Irrigators – After discussion, Commissioner Rogers made motion to allow irrigators, with verified water rights to the Sun River and an approved piping system through the levee, access over the levee to their pumping stations. Access may be through a private gate in the fence between the District property and the irrigator's property. Said gate to be: 1. Installed and maintained at the irrigator's expense, 2. Approved by the District, 3. Securely closed at all times when not in use, and 4. Access to District property is solely for the purpose of maintaining or operating the irrigator's pumping system. All other access will be considered trespassing. This does not in any way grant approval to install, modify, or make changes to a pumping station. The irrigator must utilize the permitting process in place by federal, state and local regulators. All commissioners in favor of, passed.

Public comment – Discussions were presented regarding the irrigators, trees, and beavers. Commissioner Rogers stated maps would be provided to the Commissioners regarding areas to be responsible for following up with.

Approved payments for: April Payroll - Chuck Rogers \$158.62, Scott Lankford \$158.62; Ooma April & May telephone to Janet Fulmer \$36.64; Montana State Fund Workers Compensation Insurance \$206.30.
